Subject: Letter of intent prior to grant of recognition/Permission for D.El.Ed. Course under Clause 7(9) of the NCTE (Recognition Norms and Procedure) Regulation, 2009/reg.

Sir Madam,

In terms of section 14/15 of the NCE Act, 1993 your Institution had submitted an application to the Northern Regional Committee of NCTE for grant of recognition for starting D.El.Ed. Course in the proposed institution i.e. Vidya Mandir Shikshan Sansthan, Plot/Khasra No.- 548, Street Number- 548, 549, Village - Rahmat Nagar, Post Office- Maniram, Tehsil/Taluka- Sadar, Town/City- Gorakhpur, District- Gorakhpur, State- Uttar Pradesh, Pin Code- 273007.

2. The NRC, NCTE on the basis of the scrutiny of the documents submitted by the institution, input received from the Visiting Team Report and videography in its 200th meeting held on 20th June 2012 to 24th June 2012, observed that the above institution has adequate financial resources, accommodation, library and laboratory as prescribed in the norms and standards and that it fulfils all such other conditions relating to infrastructural and instructional facilities required for proper functioning of the institution for a teacher education course. Therefore, the NRC, decided to issue letter of intent prior to grant of recognition for D.El.Ed. Course under clause 7(9) of the NCTE Regulations 2009 to the Institution.
3. As per provision of clause 7(9) of NCTE Regulations, 2009. The process of appointment of qualified staff as per policy of State Government or University Grant Commission or University may be initiated by the institution and affiliating body will provided all assistance to the institution to ensure that the staff of faculty is appointed as per National Council for Teacher Education norms within two months. The institution shall submit the list of faculty, as approved by the affiliating body, to the Regional Committee.
4. In this regard as per decision taken by NRC in its 200th meeting it is clarified that the above implies that where there exists a provision of nomination of experts for the Selection Committee by the affiliating university the same be adhered to. In the absence of such a provision in the Act/Statutes of the affiliating university, the institution shall select faculty members by employing a transparent, objective and judicious process and shall get the list of selected teachers approved by the affiliating university. This approved list, along with details of educational qualifications and teaching experience, shall be submitted by the institution to the Regional Committee.
5. In view of above, before grant of formal recognition under Regulation 7(11) of NCTE Regulation 2009 is considered, the following documents are required to be submitted by the institution:-
 - a. The institution shall submit particulars of the staff duly approved by the University/affiliating body as per the prescribed format available in the NRC, NCTE website.
 - b. Advertisement in leading newspapers.
 - c. Recommendations of the Selection Committee for appointment of teaching & non-teaching staff as per the norms of the affiliating body.
 - d. An affidavit on Rs. 100/-stamp paper to the effect that the institution has selected staff as per NCTE/State/University norms.(format Enclosed)

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
